Since 1971, LPCHS has been dedicated to helping animals in need by providing shelter for the homeless, rescuing those in distress, and assisting in the investigation of cruelty and abuse. Our mission is centered on finding forever homes for our animals while fostering kindness and responsibility toward all living things through humane education.

Based in Durango, CO, and serving the Four Corners region, LPCHS cares for approximately 3,000 animals each year with the help of 50 staff members and over 300 passionate volunteers. As an open-admission shelter, we welcome every animal in need, providing medical and behavioral assessments, adoption services, and critical care. Our efforts extend beyond the shelter through our Medical Services Department, offering low-cost spay/neuter, vaccinations, and micro-chipping to the community, and our Animal Protection Services team, which works with local authorities to keep animals safe.

Through participation in ReelTime Animal Rescue's Compassion Education program, we're thrilled to expand our reach even further, connecting with students worldwide to share the importance of kindness, responsibility, and animal welfare.
